Neighborhood Health Offering Comprehensive Health Services Amid COVID-19 Pandemic

Fort Wayne, IN – Amid the COVID-19 pandemic Neighborhood Health has adjusted the way they serve patients to ensure the health and safety of everyone in the community.

Now introducing [Video Visits](#), current and new patients can connect with a medical provider through their video and audio enabled desktop or laptop, smartphone, or any other internet-ready device. This service is to continue to treat patients for certain symptoms that they do not need to physically be present for. Providers can see how the patient is doing and to come up with a treatment plan.

Along with Telehealth, in-office visits are still available but with adjusted procedures for all services. The Calhoun office is seeing patients for well and preventive visits, pediatric and adult wellness, immunizations, health screenings, chronic disease management, prenatal and women's health, family planning, and FREE pregnancy testing. This location has also resumed elective dental procedures and vision services effective April 27, 2020 following [Governor Holcomb](#), the [Indiana Dental Association](#), and the [Indiana Optometric Association's](#) direction. The Southeast office has been modified to treat patients for sick and respiratory visits ONLY.

If you need to schedule an in-office appointment, Neighborhood Health asks that you wear a mask upon entering our buildings. If you do not have a mask, one will be issued to you and you must wear it throughout the duration of your visit. In addition to these precautions we are only allowing patients to enter our buildings. Visitors are not permitted unless they are a caregiver or guardian for minors and adults. All other family members and guests will be asked to wait outside the building or in their vehicle.

Neighborhood Health is also offering COVID-19 testing at its Southeast office for current and new patients. Those who are uninsured will receive the testing for FREE. Patients who have a Medicaid, Medicare, or other health insurance plan, the lab fee will be covered with no copays or deductibles.
