## NEWS RELEASE - Neighborhood Health selected as The Big Give grant recipient

Organization launches community crowdfunding campaign on Giving Tuesday

FORT WAYNE, INDIANA, Nov. 29, 2022, — Neighborhood Health has been selected as the final recipient of The Big Give grant, as announced by the Do it Best Foundation. The Big Give offers a grant of \$100,000, plus a 1:1 match of up to \$50,000.

Neighborhood Health recently announced a major investment in southeast Fort Wayne, as it acquired the Ward building at 3501 Warsaw St. and shared a vision for a community health center that will provide primary care, prenatal health services, dental, behavioral health and WIC wraparound support. In order to secure the full grant amount from the Do it Best Foundation, Neighborhood Health has kicked off a crowdfunding campaign. Neighborhood Health has a goal to raise \$50,000 through this campaign in order to secure the 1:1 match through the Do it Best Foundation.

Infant mortality rates provide information on overall community health, and improving these rates requires a holistic healthcare approach for all residents, including physical health and mental health services."

Rich Lynch, president of the Do it Best Foundation and vice president of marketing for Do it Best, said, "The Do it Best Foundation believes its grant will help Neighborhood Health continue to make a major impact in Fort Wayne and Northeast Indiana through its focus on community health and infant mortality.
